All you need is an emulator, a PS1 BIOS and your old PS1 games. Here's how to play PlayStation One (PS1) games on your PC! What is the best PS1 emulator? An emulator is a type of software installed on your PC. It allows you to play physical hardware in a software setting, all from the comfort of your existing computer. There are emulators for various types of hardware and platforms. A game emulator plays a game console, allowing you to play anything from a Commodore 64 to an arcade game closet, from a Nintendo 64 to a PlayStation 1, all without the need for the original console. There are a lot of PS1 emulators out there. However, ePSXe remains the best option for additional performance, stability, and functionality. Updates are slow, but ePSXe has over a decade of development under its belt, making it a great option to start playing your old PS1 games once again. So, let's start with ePSXe. How to download the first things about ePSXe first: you need to download the latest version of ePSXe. Download: ePSXe for Windows (free) There is no installation process for ePSXe. The files are extracted from the store and then run ePSXe from the same folder. Right-click the ePSXe download, select the ZIP program, and check out. Not sure what an archive and ZIP program are? Read our guide explaining how to extract files from common archives before continuing with this tutorial. When you run ePSXe for the first time, you may encounter a dialog box asking you to extract additional files. Pull them out, then Epsxe. There are several steps to complete before you can play a PS1 game in the ePSXe emulator. Before anything happens, you need a PlayStation 1 BIOS. A BIOS is a low-level software that starts when your computer starts and is usually associated with your PC. The BIOS BIOS 1 use is slightly different from the one used by your PC. The PS1 BIOS contains information about playstation 1 hardware, such as version, work area, and more. ePSXe does not run without a correct PS1 BIOS. The PlayStation 1 BIOS also determines which games you can play, depending on its region (such as Europe, North America, Japan, and so on). There are simulated PS1 BIOS files, but they don't work as well as the real deal. Disclaimer: Although PS1 BIOS files are available online, the only legal method to obtain BIOS files is to rip the BIOS from the existing PS1. Check out the following video to figure out exactly how to rip the PS1 BIOS. Rip the PS1 BIOS at your peril. After you copy the PS1 BIOS, you must copy and paste the store to the BIOS directory. The BIOS directory is located in the ePSXe folder. The path to the ePSXe BIOS folder depends on where the emulator was extracted. For example, the ePSXe BIOS folder is C:\Users\Gavin\Downloads\lePSXe205bios. After you paste the BIOS store into the correct folder, you must check out its contents. The emulator cannot read the ZIP file, only its contents. How to configure ePSXe Once the BIOS is in place, you can continue to configure ePSXe. ePSXe Graphics Configuration First comes to a menu that displays different graphics options and tips from the ePSXe development team. If you have an AMD or Nvidia graphics card, select Pete's OpenGL2 Core GPU 2.0.0 and click Config. There are plenty of graphics options here that you can set up. Over time, you can change settings as you become more familiar with what they do. How you change your ePSXe experience depends on your graphics card. Most modern computers exceed the capabilities of the original PS1, which had a 33.0 MHz CPU (yes, megahertz--- was the beginning of the 90s!), 2 MB of RAM and 1 MB of VRAM. This means that the average PC can use the full range of ePSXe graphics configuration options. I would recommend running the PlayStation 1 game you want to play first, then making graphical changes later. Plus, you can also check out our short guide to video game graphics and settings. Describes in detail how certain graphics settings affect performance and visual effects for all games, not just ePSXe. There is an easy graphic editing option that you can do right now. The default options are available in the lower-right corner of the configuration options. You can select fast or beautiful graphics. Here are the changes after selecting Nice graphics: the difference between the basic and beautiful graphics is noticeable, even on the game's loading screens. For example, here's the loading screen of Bandicoot using the default graphics settings of ePSXe: And here is the same loading screen as Crash Bandicoot using nice graphics options: you can see that the logo, menu letters, background and character of the game are much smoother in the second image. Configuring ePSXe Sound, Drive, and Controller Now for Sound Sound It is easier to leave this as the default option as ePSXe handles most PS1 games well. Next up is the CD-ROM plug-in. If you're using Windows 10, select ePSXe CDR WNT/W2K core 2.0.0, and then continue. Finally, you can configure controllers for use with ePSXe. ePSXe supports several controllers outside the box. Click the drop-down menu in the upper-right corner to choose the input type. You can select between keyboard, keyboard and mouse, Direct Input, and XInput. If you're using an Xbox 360 or Xbox One controller, select XInput. It will automatically map the controller and your game should play without flaws. If you're using a PlayStation DualShock controller, see the following guide that explains how to use a PS4 controller on a PC or Mac. There is also a specific guide on how to connect a DualShock controller to ePSXe. How to get PS1 games on Windows 10 Now that ePSXe is ready, you can choose your favorite PS1 games and fire them. PlayStation 1 games are available for free online. However, MakeUseOf can't help you find them. Downloading data files for games you don't own is piracy. ePSXe can run files that use bin, ISO, CUE, IMG, CD, and some others extensions. These files refer to disk images that contain PS1 game data. You can rip your original PS1 games in the same way that you could rip a DVD from your computer. However, you need to make sure that the output file is an ISO (or one of the other PS1 game file formats that ePSXe accepts) otherwise your PS1 game won't load. Once you're ready for the PS1 ISO, you can upload it to ePSXe. Go to File &gt; Run ISO, and then go to the PS1 game path. Select the PS1 game file and it will start uploading it. Here it is. Now you're playing a PS1 game on your PC! Tips on using ePSXe From here on out, you can play your PS1 games using whatever control scheme you decide. However, here are some tips to help your ePSXe experience run smoothly. To exit ePSXe emulation, press ESC. You'll return to the ePSXe home screen. From the home screen, you can adjust emulation settings, controller settings, and much more. To get back to the game, go to Run &gt; Continue. You can save and upload games from the main menu. Go to the Run menu, then save status or upload status, depending on what you want to do. ePSXe also emulates PlayStation 1 memory cards so you can create a save file within your game. If the game you're playing has multiple discs (like Final Fantasy 7), you can move on to the next one using File &gt; Change Disc, and then select the next disc. Local multiplayer is available. You can use a combination of gamepad and keyboard to make sure each person has a controller. ePSXe also simulates Multitap, which allows up to four local players in the same game. You can improve ePSXe and your PS1 games with additional plugins. Figuring out which plugins work best with your setup and with whatever game you want to play is tricky at times. However, you can check the recommended recommended list Plug-in ePSXe and figure out which plugins work with your PC.
